JOURNEY INTO THE WRECK

DAY 1: ARRIVAL AT AMED

Arrive at Jukung Dive Resort and settle into your accommodation. Meet the team, get fitted for your dive equipment, and receive a short briefing for the days ahead. The rest of the day is yours to relax or explore Amed.

DAY 2: USAT LIBERTY SHIPWRECK

Enjoy two guided dives at the world-famous USAT Liberty Shipwreck, exploring different sections of this iconic site surrounded by vibrant marine life. Afternoon at ease, or can add extra shore dives at the price of 30\$US or night dive at the price of 50\$US

DAY 3: JAPANESE SHIPWRECK

Dive the Japanese Wreck with two guided dives at this coral-covered site, known for its quieter setting and excellent macro life. Afternoon can explore Amed or nearby area or add dives like the day before

DAY 4: KUBU WRECK

Complete your experience with two guided dives at the Kubu Wreck, a deeper site suited to more experienced divers. Afternoon departure from Amed for the south or can extend your stay and make more diving!

IMPORTANT INFORMATION:

The Kubu Wreck dives require Advanced Open Water certification or equivalent due to depth; if this is not held, alternative dive sites can be arranged. Dive and travel insurance are not included and are recommended for all guests. Transfers to and from Amed are not included but can be arranged as an add-on, please let us know your travel plans and we will be happy to assist. Dive sites are subject to conditions including tides, weather, and diver experience levels. Marine life sightings cannot be guaranteed. Full terms and conditions apply.
